- Check if your files will fit on a DVD

If you have a large project with big files, then you want to make sure they will fit on a DVD with optimal quality. Simply load your files in any of our video conversion program and check the conversion advisor at the bottom of the treeview. The color is an indication of the size and quality of the project. If it's in the red or orange, you will have to use a Double Layer DVD (DL DVD or DVD -9) or remove files to lighten the project.
